GRR Mission Grants

GRR grants for 2019 are offered to encourage and empower GRR churches to make God’s mission their passion in new ways. These are matching grants that can be used by GRR churches for just about any **new** ministry (activity, event, project) directed toward those outside the church. It may be an activity in the surrounding community or something halfway around the world. **But it must engage the members of the applying church** (i.e.: the grant money is not to send to someone else).

This is how it works:

The church designs a **new** ministry that is focused on people not regularly associated with the church. That effort might be a program over several weeks or a single event. Be creative as you look at the needs around you. Show the cost of the mission project/activity in your regular budget for 2019. Based on the merit of the proposal and the availability of funds, GRR will award a matching grant (up to a maximum of \$1500) to the church for enhancing the financial support of new mission initiatives.

Who may apply for grants? Any GRR church in good standing. “Good standing” is evidenced by (1) a current annual report on file in the Regional office and (2) having contributed to the financial support of the Region, either through United Mission, America for Christ, or Specifics during 2018. Priority will be given to churches that have not received a grant previously.

GRR Intern Grant Program

Many churches have discovered that part-time internship programs provide an effective means for churches to enhance their existing ministries or to explore new ministries during the summer months. These internships not only expand the ministry of the church, they also provide a significant opportunity for people to explore ministry vocations and to receive meaningful coaching in ministry.

The GRR Intern Grant Program is designed to challenge GRR churches to use interns to enhance existing ministries or to explore new ministries. Funding of this program is made possible by the Des Peres Legacy. This is how it works:

The church designs a ministry that would benefit from a Summer Intern. The design includes the ministry to be done, the time frame for the ministry, and a plan for ongoing training, coaching and evaluation. The church will prepare a job description for the internship, and commit funds in its regular church budget. Based on the merit of the proposal and the availability of funds, GRR will award a matching grant (up to a maximum of \$3,000) to the church for enhancing the financial support of the Intern.

Any GRR church in good standing with the Region can apply. **Applications are due April 30, 2019.** Check the GRR website (www.abcgrr.org) for more information and an application
